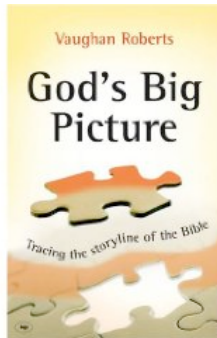




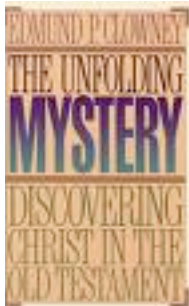

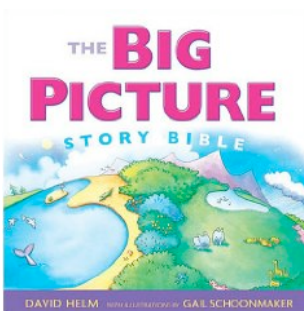
God's Big Picture (Vaughan Roberts)

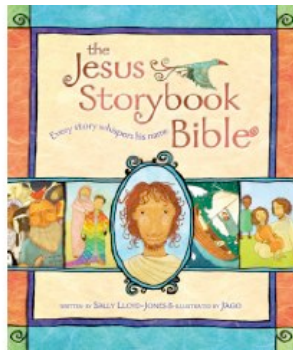
The Unfolding Mystery (Edmund Clowney)

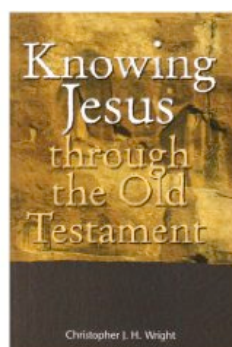
The Jesus StoryBook Bible (Sally Lloyd-Jones & Jago)
